

Exhibition of Proposed San Isidore Village Septic System Upgrade Financial Assistance Program

Council hereby gives public notice of the exhibition of its Proposed San Isidore Village Septic System Upgrade Financial Assistance Program.

The draft Financial Assistance Program will be on exhibition from Thursday 29 November 2017 until Monday 29 January 2018. Council invites public submissions on the proposed program, to be lodged within the exhibition period.

The proposed Financial Assistance program would provide:

- A one off subsidy of up to \$690.00 for the upgrading of San Isidore Village Ratepayers Septic systems provided they currently have a registered septic system with Wagga Wagga City Council.
- Evidence of a septic system upgrade and applicable Council fees paid must be submitted when applying for the subsidy with only upgrades carried out since 27 November 2017 (the date Council resolved not to proceed with the San Isidore Village Sewer Scheme) are eligible for the subsidy.
- The subsidy program is proposed to end 30 June 2020, which will allow upgrades to be undertaken given the removal of the San Isidore Village Sewer Scheme from Council's plans.
- A subsidy may only be claimed once, upon producing paid Council receipts whereby Council will reimburse the amount paid up to a maximum of \$690.00.

Submission Procedure: Persons wishing to make a submission in relation to the proposed Financial Assistance program should do so prior to the close of the exhibition period. Submissions should be in writing and may be delivered to Wagga Wagga City Council or mailed to the General Manager, Wagga Wagga City Council, PO Box 20, Wagga Wagga, NSW 2650 or emailed to council@wagga.nsw.gov.au. Persons making written submissions regarding the above proposed program are advised that any submission received within the submission period will be subject to the *Government Information (Public Access) Act 2009* and the *Privacy and Personal Information Protection Act (PIPPA)* and may be attached to the final report, in its entirety or in part, to Council unless explicitly requested by the person making the submission that they do not wish this to occur.
